At Normandy Invasion had to climb^a rope ladder to top of steep cliffs. Fellow soldiers were very protective of female nurse. After 7 days travel in train without facilities, on K-Rations I was constipated and finally found outhouse toilet - when bomb went off close-by and scared the "s. t" out of me. I shared this experience with my fellow nurses as a good sense of humor is important to get through stressful situations. Casualties didn't think of nurses as females or sex objects, but as mothers trying to take away their pain and make them better.
