## **PROFESSOR LAWRENCE M. LEW**

Professor Lawrence M. Lew is a distinguished authority on Foreign Policy and Diplomacy.

He was born and educated in China where he graduated from the University of Nanking Magna Cum Laude. He did graduate work at Butler University and the University of Chicago. Upon his return to China, he taught and later became Dean of the College of Liberal Arts at his Alma Mater. From 1923 until he came to Leisure World in 1972, he enjoyed outstanding careers as a professor, senior expert on Foreign Affairs, and administrator or consultant to many departments and bureaus of the governments of China, the United States and Great Britain. Numbered among his friends and associates are many world leaders.

Professor Lew and his wife, Grace, have travelled extensively in China covering the principal cities and regions of the country. They have also travelled the world three times making studies in scores of countries. Professor Lew is the author of numerous articles, some in Chinese, and was a contributor to the *Encyclopedia Britannica*, Vol. XIV, and to the *Dictionary of Political Science*.

Since coming to Leisure World, Professor Lew has been active in the Leisure World Foreign Policy Association as a member of the Board and as a group discussion leader.

As professor emeritus, he continues to be a keen, daily student of world diplomacy and foreign affairs. He makes ten to twelve major speeches annually, each of which he carefully prepares with in-depth studies. These personal appearances invariably draw huge attendance and are considered highlight events by the organizations which sponsor them.
