OUR DIVISION SPEARHEADED THE ENTIRE FIRST ARMY ACROSS GERMANY, UNTIL WE RECEIVED ORDERS TO STOP AND WE WERE REPLACED BY THE 69TH INFANTRY DIV. WHO MADE CONTACT WITH THE RUSSIANS ABOUT TWO DAYS LATER. OUR DIVISION WAS REASSIGNED TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND LIBERATED A FEW TOWNS, WHEN THE WAR FINALLY ENDED
