

**My name is Bertram J. Black. I live at 2399 Via Mariposa W. My wife and I moved to Leisure World in 1992 from New York, and have been thoroughly enjoying the Leisure World community ever since.**

**I was born in England, brought up in Chicago and St. Louis, Missouri, and spent my adult years in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and mostly in New York City. My college and graduate degrees are from Washington University in St. Louis.**

**The major part of my professional career has been in the rehabilitation of persons suffering from chronic illnesses, mainly tuberculosis, heart disease, mental illnesses and developmental disabilities. I have directed programs in both the private and public spheres, including a large private agency dealing with vocational rehabilitation and with large state institutions serving the mentally ill and disabled. I have also been responsible for health planning, privately in Pittsburgh and as a city commissioner in New York City.**

**I have taught in a number of universities. For almost 20 years before retiring I carried responsibility for programs in rehabilitation at the state institutions in the Bronx, New York and as Professor of Psychiatry and Community Health at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. At present I hold positions of Professor Emeritus of Psychiatry and of Professor Emeritus of Epidemiology and Social Medicine at that medical school.**

**The rehabilitation agency that I administered for 17 years operated a business in the open competitive market employing a couple of hundred disabled workers. As president of that business I gained familiarity with marketing and sales and purchasing, along with finance and budgeting. I have also served as treasurer of large organizations dealing with millions of dollars, and with budgeting procedures in both the non-governmental and governmental fields.**

**I have been called upon to serve on many boards, commissions, and advisory bodies nationally, statewide, and locally. On a number of these I have been the chairperson or the secretary-treasurer. While most of these have been in the fields of health or welfare or rehabilitation, a number have dealt with economic issues.**

**In Leisure World I have been a member of the Audibon Society, the Macintosh Computer Club, the Historical Society, The Community Association, the Society for Concerned Citizens the People for a National Health Program, and the Academians. For the Historical Society I am on the committee guiding the program of relationship to the UCI Brain Institute surveys. I was a founding Board Member of the Leisure World Foundation and a founding supporter of the City of Laguna Woods.**

**For four and a half years I was a director of the Third Mutual Board and served as its secretary and as its treasurer. On the GRF Board I serve on its Community Activities Committee and its Committee on Government and Public Relations. I have also seen service on its Finance Committee and its Maintenance and Construction Committee. As you may know I have spent a goodly amount of time these past two years in chairing the Bus Utilization Advisory Committee and we have brought to a successful conclusion the new scheduling for Leisure World's bus system.**

**I enjoy the swimming pools and walking the pleasant paths in Leisure World. My wife and I have participated in classes of the Saddleback Emeritus program, and in the Film Club and the Community Concerts.**

**I believe that my experiences in professional, business, and voluntary activities have been of value on the Board of the Golden Rain Foundation. I am particularly concerned with preserving the valuable resources of the Leisure World community, physical, recreational, and educational, and of ensuring the capabilities of its residents to enjoy them. The coming years continue to bring serious challenges to the leadership of Leisure World - how to preserve fiscal stability and our amenities of living. We have to develop more of a working relationship with our new City government and continue our fight against the establishment of a commercial airport. I would like to continue to assist in helping my fellow residents in facing them.**
