

Golden Rain director dies

Golden Rain Director Bertram Black died Monday, April 8 at Saddleback Hospital.

Black, a former director of Third Mutual and a Leisure Worlder of the Month honoree, was a retired health care professional, professor and the author of numerous books and publications in his field.

He also was an active member of Leisure World clubs, like Concerned Citizens, People for a National Health Program and the Community Civic Association, and was reelected to his Golden Rain Foundation seat last year.

A memorial service has been set up at 11 a.m., Saturday, April 20 in Clubhouse 3, Dining Room 2.
