# LEISURE WORLDER of the Month

JOSEPH AND MARGARET ROBB BRADY

LAGUNA HILLS - Joseph and Margaret Robb Brady have been married fifty years. Their dedication to each other has lasted half a century, and so has their commitment to serving their community and other people. Today, their list of honors and awards is impressive, and their commitment to service is as strong as ever. In August they will share another honor. The Bradys will be named the "Leisure Worlders of the Month." A ceremony, sponsored by Home Federal Savings and the Leisure World Historical Society, will begin at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, August 3, in Clubhouse Six and is open to the public.

After graduation from the University of Michigan in 1926, Joe went to work at the Citizen Insurance Company of Howell, Michigan.

Margaret also joined Citizen after her graduation from the University of Michigan. In 1938 they were married. They have three children and six grandchildren.

Throughout their marriage, both of the Bradys committed themselves to numerous organizations.

"I was president of the Rotary Club, the Chamber of Commerce, the University of Michigan Club, and the University of Michigan International Alumni Association," Joe said.

He chaired drives for the March of Dimes and Salvation Army. He was a member of the Michigan State Chamber of Commerce, treasurer of Citizens for Michigan and district governor of Rotary International.

He received a Distinguished Alumni Service Award from the University of Michigan, an Honorary Doctor's Degree from Cleary College and the Howell Chamber of Commerce "Citizen of the Year" award.

In 1967, Joe retired as President of the Citizens Insurance Company of Howell. He received a Concurrent Senate and House Resolution of Tribute from the Michigan Legislature.

The couple moved into Leisure World in 1974 and have remained active in community affairs.

Both served as president of the Leisure World University of Michigan Club and Margaret is now treasurer. They are also members of the Leisure World Historical Society.

Both are members of the Theater Guild, and life members of the Saddleback Hospital Thrift Shop, when they volunteer together on Wednesday mornings and assist with the weekly Thrift Shop TV Show on Channel 6.

She is a Chairman of the Day and has served on the Board as Vice President of Public Relations for the Thrift shop.

Both have served as president of the Leisure World Saddle Club (Margaret was the first woman to hold that office). They have been members of two Saddle Club drill teams at the Leisure Worlde Equestrian Center and have participated in several horse shows.

And, fifty years later, this dedicated couple shows no signs of letting up on their dedication to serving others and volunteering their time.
