“Having the time and health to volunteer”

Charlotte Brady has traveled widely and has lived in Germany for eight years and in Paris for six years, where among other things she attended the University of Paris. The main focus of her working life has been as a Teacher and she has taught in both Germany and France as well as the Palos Verdes, CA school system from which she retired in 1989.
