

Leisure Worlder of Month to be honored

The Leisure Worlder of the Month ceremony honoring Irma Franklin will be conducted at 10 a.m. Wednesday, June 2 at the Rossmoor Pavilion.

Former home of Rossmoor New Sales, the pavilion is located at Paseo de Valencia and Avenida de la Carlota across from Bob's Big Boy Restaurant.

The traditional setting has been retained by the program sponsors, Home Federal Savings and the Leisure World Historical Society in order to accommodate the large number of residents who attend the open events.

The honoree's portrait is then moved to Home Federal's local office for public view-

ing before being presented to the recipient at a similar ceremony one month later.

A veteran library volunteer in Leisure World and a former business educator, Miss Franklin is the 78th community leader selected for the award inaugurated in 1976 by Rossmoor Corp. The program was acquired in August 1981 by Home Federal, with the Historical Society serving as consultant in the selection of recipients.

Miss Franklin follows John W. Luhring, Leisure Worlder of the Month for May. Luhring is a former bank executive and Southwestern Law School president who serves as Third Mutual president.
