# String ensemble takes stage Sunday in annual concert

Under the leadership of its new director, Dorothy Hendricks, the Laguna Hills String Ensemble will present its 13th annual spring concert Sunday, May 6 at 2:30 p.m. in the Clubhouse 3 auditorium.

The program will include a group of pieces by German composers, a suite by the Russian composer Arensky, and short lyrical compositions by Glazounov and Braein.

Special guest organist Lois Lux will play Boellmann's "Suite Gothique" and a toccata for organ by Titcomb. To close the program, she will join the ensemble in Mendelssohn's "March of the Priests."

Mrs. Lux is organist for the Mayflower Church and accompanist for the Leisure World Chorale. She has appeared in recital at the Geneva Presbyterian Church and has filled in at the Baptist and Methodist churches also.

A graduate of UCLA, she spent many years as church organist and teacher in Palm Springs before moving to Leisure World.
