SUBJECT: Leisure Worlder of the Month for November 1987.

As you are aware, each month Home Federal Savings and Loan and the Leisure World Historical Society select a Leisure Worlder of the Month. The honor this month has been bestowed upon Laura McKeever.

Laura attended the University of California at Berkeley, graduating with teaching credentials and finally a Master's Degree in English. From there she was offered a position in Fallbrook because a campus friend knew of the vacancy and recommended her.

From 1928 to 1945, Laura taught English, Drama, Latin and the usual extra activities at Fallbrook Union High School. After the end of World War II, she decided it was time to move on. Laura spent the next 20 years at Poly High School in Riverside as Senior Girls Counselor and Girls Service Club Advisor in addition to teaching classes in English, mainly to college-preparatory seniors.

When the rapid growth of Riverside required the building of two campuses to replace Poly High, Laura decided to retire rather than start a new career. With the guidance and advice of a close friend, Laura made her move to Leisure World.

During her term as President of Ebell from 1971 through 1973, Laura helped organize "Resocialization Teams" which met weekly to provide games, refreshments and companionship to stroke victims and handicapped persons.

Miss McKeever keeps busy with the Philharmonic, Forum, Performing Arts activities and, most recently, as a volunteer with the Saddleback Valley Eye Center support group.

A color portrait will be unveiled Wednesday, November 4, 1987, during a ceremony at Clubhouse 6 at 10:00 A.M. Please join me in congratulating Miss Laura McKeever on this well-deserved honor.
