## Pedrotti honored at dinner

Elizabeth Pedrotti of Leisure World, former president of the Diocese of Orange Catholic Community Agencies Auxiliary, was honored by a resolution of the Orange County Board of Supervisors during the recent annual Caritas Christi dinner.

Miss Pedrotti, who was instrumental in originating the annual dinner benefit for Catholic Social Service, was presented with the resolution by Supervisor Roger Stanton. Stanton was master of ceremonies

for the event at the Grand Hotel, which also celebrated the birthday of His Excellency the Most Rev. William R. Johnson, bishop of Orange.

The resolution, initiated by Supervisor Thomas F. Riley, commends Miss Pedrotti "on her commitment to faith on behalf of the Catholic residents of Orange County."

It notes that after Miss Pedrotti moved to Leisure World in Laguna Hills in 1966, she served as the first secretary of the Rev. Monsignor Otto Spor-

rer in the newly formed St. Nicholas Parish.

During her two terms as president of the Catholic Community Agencies Auxiliary, the organization expanded by three chapters. Miss Pedrotti has served on the board of directors of Catholic Social Service, one of the Catholic Community Agencies.

The resolution further states that she is now involved in developing a Catholic retirement home in Laguna Hills.
