# Golden Rain director dies after fall

Golden Rain Foundation Director Al Potter, 76, died Saturday, March 27, at Beverly Manor Convalescent Home.

Mr. Potter was in the process of giving a book review to the Aliso Club on March 19 in Clubhouse 3, when he fainted, hitting his head. He was taken to Saddleback Memorial Medical Center and was transferred to Beverly Manor on March 26.

A retired owner of a water-treatment company in Iowa, Mr. Potter is survived by his wife Portia; daughter, Mrs. Ronald (Georganne) Friedrich and four grandchildren of Dallas; brothers Robert, of Morrison, Ill., and James of Arcadia, Ca.

There will be a memorial service Friday, at 11 a.m. at Geneva Presbyterian-Church.

The Potters moved to Leisure World in 1976. He was elected to

the Third Laguna Hills Mutual Board in 1984; the Golden Rain Foundation Board in 1987; and Third Laguna again in 1992. He served as Golden Rain treasurer in 1989-90.

An active member of the community, Mr. Potter was named a Leisure Worlder of the Month in May 1988. He was also a past president of the Tennis Club, an active member of Opera 100, the Men's Golf Club, Writer's and Publishers Club, Kiwanis and Toastmasters where he was scheduled to speak at a District competition on April 2.
