A member of Who's Who in California, for the last 10 years the people of Orange County have benefited from Herbert Schwartz' community service in various organizations both in and out of Leisure World.

To show appreciation for all he has done, Herbert will be honored as "Leisure Worlder of the Month," on Wednesday, April 5. His special ceremony will be held at 10:00 a.m., in Clubhouse Six. The public is invited to attend the program, which is sponsored jointly by Home Federal Savings and Loan and Leisure World Historical Society.

Herbert earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from New York University. He went on to become a certified public accountant with Alexander Grant and Company where he was a partner. Herbert practiced in New York and then California, where he retired in 1977.

He lived in New York City and then Providence, Rhode Island before enlisting in the U.S. Coast Guard in 1941.

Herbert married Ada, they have a daughter Roslyn. He completed his military service in 1945.

Herbert and his wife moved to Leisure World in 1978. He is founder and president of the Friends of the Library Foundation of Orange County. The foundation brings all Friends of the Library groups of Orange County into one organization to develop better communication and programming in its relations with the user community. He was director and treasurer of the Mutual 75 group, president of fifth Laguna Hills Mutual, director and treasurer of the Golden Rain Foundation and Director of the Saddleback Area Coordinating Council.

Some of his non-Leisure World Activities include: director, chairman and treasurer of the Orange County Community Development Council, director of the Orange County American Red Cross, member of the Orange County Chamber of Commerce and a member of the finance committee for the Republican Party of Orange County.
