

# Studebaker leaves Golden Rain board

Golden Rain Foundation Director Phil Studebaker resigned yesterday from the GRF Board for health reasons, Al Hanson, GRF President, announced.

Studebaker, who has served on the Board for a year, was also president of United Mutual in 1987-88.

Director Sherwood Heiser has been appointed to take over as chairman of the Community Activities Committee,

which Studebaker had headed, Hanson said. The GRF Nominating Committee meets today to begin the selection process of a candidate to take Studebaker's seat on the Board.

According to the bylaws, the Committee has 15 days to make a selection, and an election must be held within 10 days after that, meaning a new director will be elected by July 30.
