

Troy elected GRF president

Herb Troy was elected the new president of the Golden Rain Foundation at the GRF organizational meeting Monday afternoon, following the election of six new directors.

Elected at the morning meeting of all directors, for the five, three-year terms were Easton Roberts, Rodney Burns, Herbert Schwartz, Arthur Briggs and George Williams. Elected to serve a one-year term was Blaine Davis.

Votes for GRF are cast by the directors of the community's mutual corporations with each director having a number of votes based on the number of members in the mutual.

United Laguna, the largest corporation, has the largest block of votes and only two of the 14 men nominated for the five, three-year and one, one-year terms were from United: Williams and Davis. Davis and Briggs were the only elected candidates with no mutual experience.

There was one nomination from the floor Monday morning before the balloting. Third Laguna Director Norman Garton nominated Mary Drane, a recent Third Laguna director. He told the directors that Mrs. Drane, who has a masters degree in business, "takes the best notes of anyone and is

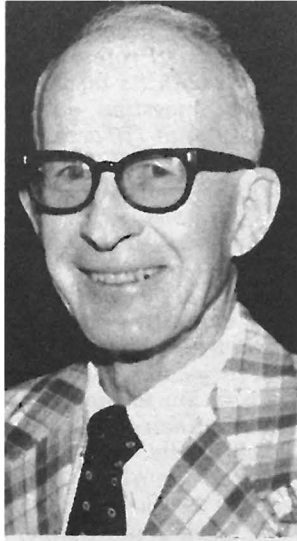
most thorough."
