Catherine Louise Wright passed away July 11, 1992 at the age of 95. Preceded in death by her parents and her three brothers, William, Cameron and Dalton, she is survived by her nephew, James Wright and nieces, Virginia Stone, Patricia McDonald, Peggy Fauquier and Antoinette DeCunzo. A graduate of Hollywood High School, Reed College and USC (Ed. '22), a 50 year resident of Beverly Hills, she lived in Orange County for the last 25 years. She taught at Virgil Junior High

School for 40 years and was founder-chairman of the Los Angeles Chapter of the Muscular Dystrophy Association. Among the first residents of Leisure World Laguna Hills, Katy was a charter member of its medical center volunteers and its Historical Society, the second president of Panhellenic, the founder of the Leisure World Library, a member of Kappa Delta, Ebell Club, Delta Kappa Gamma, Geneva Presbyterian Church and the first woman to be honored as a Leisure Worlder of the Month. The Muscular Dystrophy Association dedicated its Annual Report to her "in grateful acknowledgment to a generous and compassionate woman who has served with unparalleled skill and devotion." That sums up how she led her life. Katy will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved her. At her request there will be no services and her ashes will be scattered at sea.
